

经过五年的赠鞋实践，他已成为该领域专家，将目光又转向了一项新的民生需求——视力保护。2011年6月7日TOMS启动了“护眼用品卖一捐一” (One for One Eyewear) 项目，每卖出一款保护视力的产品就会向有需求者提供眼科手术或者是具有矫正视力的眼镜。
